First Lesson

Acts 1

The Ascension of Jesus

The first narrative that I wrote for you, Theophilus, covered everything that Jesus did and taught from the beginning until that day when, after he gave instructions through the Holy Spirit to his chosen disciples, he was taken up. With a lot of hard evidence Jesus had proven that he was alive after his suffering, appearing to the disciples over the course of 40 days and speaking about the Kingdom of God. Getting the disciples together, Jesus commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, "which you heard from me. For John, on the one hand, once baptized with water, but you, on the other hand, will be baptized in the Holy Spirit not many days from now." Then, when they had come together, the disciples asked Jesus, "Lord, is this the time when you are in the process of restoring the kingdom to Israel?" *Jesus* replied, "It is not for you to know the historical or even the God-determined moment that the Father sets by his own authority. Still, you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the very end of the earth."

After he said this, the disciples watched him being lifted up and the cloud carrying him away from their sight.

And as they were intently focused on heaven, Jesus took himself across, and behold, two men in white clothes were standing by the disciples.

These two men said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven will come in the same way as you saw him going into heaven."

But let the righteous be joyful; let them exult before God; let them be jubilant with joy.


Sing to God, sing praises to the Lord's name; lift up a song to the Lord who rides upon the clouds -this one's name is the Lord--be exultant before the Lord.
