C: From the raising of the sun to its setting, the name of the Lord is to be praised.


A: It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to the Most High.

Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Go!"


So, the girl went and called the child's mother.


Pharaoh's daughter unknowingly said to the child's mother, "Take this child and nurse it for me, and I will pay you a salary."

Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord; and greet his mother--a mother to me also.


Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas, and the brothers and sisters who are with them.

Gospel Luke 7:36-8:3

ne of the Pharisees asked Jesus to eat with him, and he went into the Pharisee's house and took his place at the table. And a woman in the city, who was a sinner, having learned that Jesus was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment. She stood behind him at his feet, weeping, and began to bathe his feet with her tears and to dry them with her hair. Then she continued kissing his feet and anointing them with the ointment.

But seeing this, the Pharisee who had invited Jesus said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, he would have known who and what kind of woman this is who is touching him-- that she is a sinner." Responding, Jesus said to him, "Simon, I have something to say to you."

"Teacher," he replied, "Speak."

"A certain creditor had two debtors; one owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they could not make their payments, the creditor canceled the debts for both of them. Who then, will love the creditor more?"

Simon answered, saying, "I assume the debtor who received the greater relief."

And Jesus said to him, "You have judged correctly."

Then turning toward the woman, he said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for my feet, but she bathed my feet with her tears and dried them with her hair. You gave me no kiss, but from the time I came in she has not stopped kissing my feet. You did not anoint my head with oil, but she has anointed my feet with ointment. Therefore, I tell you, her sins, which were many, have been forgiven, because she loved with a wholistic love. But the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little."

Then Jesus said to the woman, "Your sins are forgiven."
But those who were at the table with him began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?"

And Jesus said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."

And after this, Jesus went on through cities and villages proclaiming and evangelizing the kingdom of God. "The Twelve" were with him, as well as some women who had been cured of evil spirits and weakness: Mary, called Magdalene - from whom seven demons had gone out, and Joanna - the wife of Herod's steward Chuza, and Susanna, and many others, who served them from whatever they had.




# The Lord's Prayer


