### wisdom of solomon 3

**D** ut the souls of the righteous are in the hand of God, and no torment **D** will ever touch them. In the eyes of the foolish they seemed to have died, and their departure was thought to be an affliction, and their going from us was thought to be their destruction; but, instead, they are at peace. For even though in the sight of the non-believer's the souls of the righteous are "punished" by death, we, the believers, know that their "hope" is full of immortality. Having been disciplined a little, the souls of the righteous will receive great good, because God tested them and God found them worthy - like gold in the furnace, God "tried" them, and like a sacrificial burnt offering. God accepted them. When the right time arrives the souls of the righteous will shine out and they will run like sparks running through the dead grass that has been cut too short. Then, the righteous will govern nations and rule over peoples, and the Lord will reign over all of them, forever. Those who trust in the Lord will understand "truth." and the faithful will abide with him in love, because grace and mercy will be shown to the Lord's elect, and the Lord watches over God's holv ones.

Reader: The Word of the Lord! C: Thanks be to God!





## Gospel

luke 21

After entering Jerusalem to shouts of "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord" and taking radical actions and making radical statements against the corrupted economy of the Temple, Jesus stayed to answer questions from the Jewish Religious Leadership and do some teaching.

As some of Jesus's disciples were talking about The Temple, noting how it was adorned with such beautiful stones and gifts dedicated to God, Jesus said, "As for these things that you see, the days will come when not one stone will be left upon another; all of them will be thrown down."

They asked him, "Teacher, when will this be, and what will be the sign that this is about to take place?"

And Jesus said, "Beware that *you* are not seduced! For, many will come in my name and say, 'I am he!' and 'The critical moment is near!' Do not

go after *them*. When *you* hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified, for, it is part of God's Divine Intentions that these things take place first – however, the ultimate fulfillment of all things will not follow right away."

Then Jesus also said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom! There will be great earthquakes, and, in various places, famines and plagues! And there will be dreadful portents and great signs from heaven! But before all this occurs, they will arrest you and persecute you; they will hand you over to synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors on account of my name. This will give you an opportunity to testify. Put it in your heart not to prepare your defense in advance, for I will give you a mouth and a wisdom that none of your opponents will be empowered to withstand or contradict. You will be handed over - even by parents, brothers and sisters, by relatives and friends - and those you are handed over to will put some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name. But! Not one hair of your head will be destroyed! By your endurance you have obtained your life!

## Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary and became truly human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Into your hands, O Lord, we commend ourselves and all for whom we pray, trusting in your mercy through Jesus Christ our Lord. C: Amen.






