And he said to me, "These are true words of God."


And I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth had gone, and the sea is no more. . .

#### <u>Gospel</u>

John 2:1-11

And on the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. And Jesus and his disciples were called into the wedding.

And lacking wine, the mother of Jesus says to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus says to her, "What is that to you and to me, ma'am? My hour has not yet come."

His mother says to the servants, "Whatever he may say to you, do it!" Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons.

Jesus says to them, "Fill the jars with water."

And they filled them to the very top of the brim.




